Inherit GA: The Next Generation of Preservationists

Inherit GA is an exciting initiative of The Georgia Trust for Historic Preservation designed to engage preservation-minded young professionals in educational and social activities that are important to the Georgia Trust's mission. Inherit GA cultivates and prepares the next generation of preservation leaders in Georgia. Participants visit lesser-known historic sites, take behind-the-scenes tours and take part in preservation efforts that are in progress throughout the state.

What is a Ramble?

The goal of a Ramble is to introduce the diverse historic cities and towns of our state to attendees while educating them about local history, architecture and preservation efforts. The Georgia Trust will bring the economic benefits of heritage tourism to these cities and help to develop their historic resources for the betterment of their economies. The Ramble consists of tours of historic properties, educational programs, as well as social events. Meals are included from Friday dinner to Sunday brunch. The tours are comprised of 45+ private homes, churches, courthouses, industrial sites, and other historic locations relevant to the host city's history.

Scholarship Description

The Georgia Trust for Historic Preservation will award one scholarship for an applicant and guest to attend the Fall Ramble in Savannah, Georgia taking place October 6-8, 2017. The goal is to encourage the study of historic preservation and related fields while learning about historic resources throughout the state. The scholarship will cover the full cost of registration for the applicant and one guest, valued at \$580. This includes registration for all Ramble tours, as well as all meals/cocktails from Friday dinner through Sunday brunch.

Recipients will be responsible for coordinating and covering their own travel and accommodation costs.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants should be a professional in or have a strong interest in the fields of architecture, history, historic preservation or a related field.
- Ideally, applicants should be an Inherit GA member and/or supporter of The Georgia Trust for Historic Preservation.
- Applicants must commit to attending all three days of the Fall Ramble (Friday Sunday).

Application Requirements

Applications must include:

- Application form
- Personal statement addressing why you are applying for a scholarship. Include a statement concerning your interest historic preservation.
