TRANQUILLA

Georgia Trust Heritage Level (\$225) and above are invited to a special reception at Tranquilla, a grand edifice built in 1849 for Milledgeville native Andrew Jackson Hansell, founder of the Georgia Military Institute. A preeminent symbol of southern antebellum architecture, Tranquilla was visited by Margaret Mitchell, a film director and artist in the 1930s to study the architectural details for possible use in *Gone with the Wind*. Today the home is lovingly cared for by Beth and Greg Griffin.





FRIDAY AFTERNOON RAMBLE: NOON TO 5 P.M.

MARIETTA AND KENNESAW
Backtrack to historic Marietta and Kennesaw, bustling northern suburbs of Atlanta at the foothills of Kennesaw Mountain. Discover traditional Southern charm as you explore all the bells and whistles of historic private residences in the Historic District. See the 1886 Victorian Paige House with its original gingerbread and period furnishings as well as the 1887 Trammell house that was beautifully restored by Rachel and Douglas Frey and received an Excellence in Preservation award from the Trust.

SATURDAY RAMBLE AND LUNCH: NOON TO 5 P.M.

MARIETTA
Ramble through the bustling Marietta Square and grab a bite at a charming eatery overlooking Glover Park. See magnificent homes along the most prominent streets in town like the 1851 Howell-Sessions House, a Greek Revival masterpiece said to have the largest columns on a private residence in Georgia. Tour Fair Oaks, an attention-grabbing structure built in 1851. The home received a Victorian-façade makeover at the end of the 19th century which now gives it an exotic Swiss chalet look.


SATURDAY DINNER AND COCKTAILS: 6 P.M. TO 8 P.M.

MARIETTA
Stay on track with a delicious homestyle dinner at Rockford, also known as the Smith-Manning House. This home is one of the most impressive antebellum residences in Marietta and is one of the earliest Greek Revivals built in the area. It features an interesting one-story coursed stone basement made from rock quarried from a nearby creek. Rockford served as a field hospital for the Battle of Kennesaw Mountain and was home to a Confederate General.



FRIDAY DINNER AND COCKTAILS: 6 P.M. TO 8 P.M.

KENNESAW
Have dinner at the Southern Museum of Civil War and Locomotive History, a Smithsonian affiliate. Dine with the General, a steam locomotive that made history during the Civil War and was made famous during the 1956 film "The Great Locomotive Chase." Tour the museum's impressive Civil War Collection, the Glover Machine Works, a restored early 20th century belt-driven locomotive assembly line, and the expansive Georgia railroad collection.



SATURDAY ORIENTATION AND BREAKFAST: 8:30 A.M. TO 11:30 A.M.

MARIETTA
Learn about the fascinating history of Cobb County at the historic 1935 Strand Theatre. Once a major motion picture house, the building closed its doors in 1976. In 2002 community leaders led an effort to bring back the Strand and it officially reopened in 2009. Today the Strand Theatre is an important cultural community landmark overlooking the Marietta town square.



APRIL 23

SUNDAY BRUNCH AND RAMBLE: 9 A.M. TO 2 P.M.

ACWORTH
Travel north on the Western Atlantic Railroad route and derail in historic Acworth. Enjoy a delicious brunch in the Old Mill, the oldest commercial building in town that was beautifully restored in 2014. Tour the Collins Avenue Historic District, which offers a view of 150 years of vernacular architecture ranging from an 1838 pioneer home to a 1960s brick ranch, with bungalows and folk Victorians along the way. See four 1927 bungalows designed by renowned Georgia architect Leila Ross Wilburn.
