### Luis Barragan Tour & Frida Kahlo Museum and Coyoacán

Born in Guadalajara in 1902, Luis Ramiro Barragán Morfín is regarded as the most prominent figure in modern Mexican architecture. By the time of his death in 1988, his personal and way of working had attained almost mythical status, and the interest in his oeuvre has increased ever since. Along with Mathias Goeritz, developed the so called “emotional architecture”. This style was understood as an example of an architecture whose main function is emotion. Light, color and volumes are conceived to influence the experience of the viewer.

Mexico City is not completed if miss Frida Kahlo’s blue house. Frida Kahlo, painter and highlighted representative of “Mexicanism”; For her fierce convictions, her extraordinary artworks or the ways she portrayed tradition, is worth-knowing-better figure. Enter Casa Azul, the ticket to a rich, deep-dive into Frida’s life and style. Its location is at the heart of one Mexico City’s most enchanting neighborhoods, Coyoacán.

 **Oaxaca City Tour**

Enter the most important city in the south of Mexico during the viceroyalty and also considered a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Oaxaca is a state that has treasures to discover; start your tour of this incredible city by visiting the historic center, where you can admire the zocalo, which is surrounded by ancient buildings and the imposing Cathedral of "Nuestra Señora de la Asunción" with a spectacular facade. Walk along the andador Macedonio Alcalá, an elegant avenue which is full of restaurants, craft stores and cafes with delicious coffee from Oaxaca.

Visit the Santo Domingo Cultural Center, which features important buildings such as the Templo de Santo Domingo de Guzman with an incredible baroque religious art interior, and the Ex-Convent of Santo Domingo, which houses the Ethnobotanical Garden, a museum and a popular library. You can't leave without visiting the popular Mercado de Artesanías and seeing the great work of Oaxacan artisans, who have achieved worldwide fame.

### Alebrijes and Monte Alban visit

Visit an artisan workshop where you will learn about one of the most popular handicrafts of the state of Oaxaca, the famous alebrijes. There you will see in depth the process of creation; you will have a guided tour of the workshops and you will be told the history of these crafts; an experience that will immerse you in the history and tradition of Oaxaca.

Step into the majesty of Monte Alban that will take you to explore this Zapotec city that was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1987. Walk around every corner of this wonderful place full of history, where you can admire its main structures such as "La Plataforma Sur", "El Juego de Pelota" and "El Edificio de los Danzantes".
